**Stephen Weller** – starring roles in UK tours of *Martin Guerre*, *The Producers* and *42<sup>nd</sup> Street*.

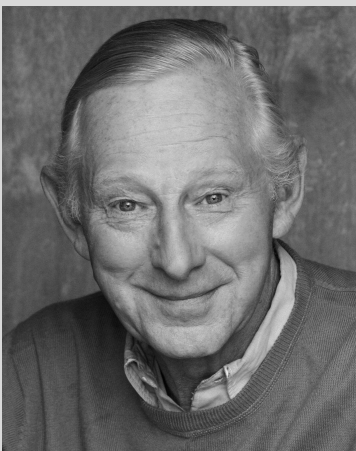


## Jeremy Nicholas

Jeremy is an actor, award-winning broadcaster, writer and musician whose one-man performance of *Three Men in Boat* won him an Olivier Award nomination. His many starring roles on television include *The Good Companions*, *The Pickwick Papers*, *Crossroads* and *Wish Me Luck*.

The author of four books on classical music, biographies of Chopin and Leopold Godowsky, over 100 CD booklets, and a collection of comic songs (*Funny You Should Sing That*),

Jeremy is President of the Jerome K Jerome Society and Director of Music at St Mary's, Bocking. He makes his home in Great Bardfield with his wife, daughter and Bumble, the world's least effective guard dog.

Jeremy's numerous TV appearances include :Father Dear Father, The Glittering Prizes, Edward and Mrs Simpson, The Edge of Darkness, First Among Equals, Game, Set & Match, Midsomer Murders, EastEnders, Casualty, and Judge John Deed.

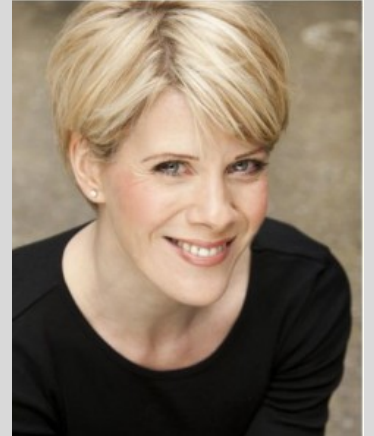

His many films include: Privilege, The Breaking of Bumbo, Oh What a lovely War and Young Winston for Richard Attenborough, The High Rd to China with Tom Selleck, Wimbledon, and The Iron Lady with Meryl Streep.

## Shona Lindsay

Shona was born in Edinburgh and brought up in the Midlands. She made her professional debut at the age of eleven in the title role of Annie and went on to play numerous children's roles in theatre and television. Leaving school to join the company of Crossroads for Central TV, Shona played Sara Briggs for two years, having originally signed for just three episodes! To mark the end of Crossroads Shona released the single Goodbye for RCA.

Shona's recording and concert work includes a Musicals Gala tour of Germany and Switzerland for Stella, the televised tribute to Ira Gershwin Who Could Ask for Anything More recorded live at the Royal Albert Hall, The Songs of the West End and Broadway for BBC Radio 2, and several West End galas with the Royal Scottish National Orchestra.



## Stephen Weller

Stephen trained at Mountview and his professional debut was in *Les Misérables* (Palace Theatre) playing Enjolras. Stephen played the title role in the 1999 cast of *Martin Guerre* (Cameron Mackintosh). Other theatre work includes Harry/Young Ebenezer opposite Shane Richie in *Scrooge* (UK Tour), as part of the West End cast of *The Producers* (Theatre Royal Drury Lane / UK Tour) playing Roger DeBris & covering Leo Bloom, and most recently Pat Denning in *42<sup>nd</sup> Street* (UK Tour)

He also toured in *You Don't Bring Me Flowers*. He has sung in various concerts, cabarets and recordings, including performances with *The WestEnders* in the UK & internationally. Stephen works with Capital Voices as a session singer, soloist and backing vocalist including for Martine McCutcheon, Michael Crawford, Will Young & Michael Ball. Stephen dedicates his performance to the memory of his loving & talented Sister.
